Burning Question:

"Does God Transform Our Troubles into Triumph?" Book of Ruth

God transforms our troubles into opportunities for praise and thanksgiving as we trust and obey Him.

I. Destitute Naomi returns to Bethlehem with Ruth (Ruth 1)

Truth: God transforms our troubles into opportunities for praise by first causing us to realize we NEED HIS HELP.

Ruth 1:21 - "I went away full, but the Lord has brought me back empty."

Application: How clearly do you see that you NEED God's help?

II. Ruth and Boaz's kindness gives Naomi HOPE (Ruth 2)

Truth: God transforms our troubles into opportunities for praise by giving us HOPE.

Ruth 2:20 - "The Lord has not stopped showing His kindness to the living and the dead. That man is our close relative; he is one of our kinsman-redeemers."

Application: What HOPE is God giving you today in your need, and what is your response?

III. Boaz marries Ruth and fathers an heir for Naomi (Ruth 3-4)

Truth: God transforms our troubles into opportunities for praise by DOING what we cannot do.

Ruth 4:14 - "Praise be to the Lord who this day has not left you without a kinsman-redeemer."

4:17 - "Naomi has a son."

Application: How willing are you to ASK God to do what you cannot do, believing He can and will transform your trouble into opportunities for praise?

"Put each difficult situation in your hands and offer it up to Jesus. You might be amazed at how God can transform that thing that is so painful to you into good for someone else." ~ Elisabeth Elliot

For Personal Reflection and Discussion with Friends and Family:

How willing are you to ASK God to do what you cannot do, believing He can and will transform your trouble into opportunities for praise? For comfort and encouragement, see John 14:27 and Isaiah 41:10.

In Preparation for Sunday, July 26, 2015:

Pastor Art will speak on the Burning Question: "What Difference Does It Make If I Believe In Creation or Not?" In preparation, ask yourself what impact the enjoyment of the natural world around you this summer (or any time) has upon your attitudes and thoughts about God. To enrich your meditation, read and ponder Psalm 104.


