# MISSIONARY OF THE WEEK

## Paul & Edna Cairns – in Chilliwack with Transport for Christ

We want to say thank you from the bottom of our hearts for standing behind us with your prayers and financial support. We thank God for you. We are well blessed.

**PRAISE ITEM:** At the end of August, our four year old grandson Stephen went in for a heart valve replacement surgery. He was born with a heart valve that the doctors thought only had one flap. A normal valve has three flaps. When they went in for surgery and got to the valve, it had two flaps fused together which doctors were able to separate the two flaps. Monitors showed that the pressure in his heart was going down so they did a few minor repairs and closed him back up. The doctors believe that the valve is stable enough for the time being. Stephen will possibly have to have the valve replacement surgery at the age of ten. We praise God for the miracles He has been performing in Stephen's heart. Please pray with us that the pressures in his heart will continue to come down. His heart will be almost full size and much stronger at ten years old.

Chaplain Paul – In July, I spent 19 days at the Chinook Winds Chapel in Calgary, training two new chaplains Emad Hanna and Rod Denton. Emad has now taken over the everyday running of the chapel. Many drivers I know from Chilliwack when hearing I was on the Calgary Chapel, would call and meet me in the Truck Stop. Others would park by the chapel and we would fellowship together outside around the picnic table. This meant putting in long days. While I was training Emad, a lady on the run from her abusive exhusband came in needing prayer. I had the joy of introducing her to the Lord and Emad lead her in the sinner's prayer. Pray for me as I will be seeing different specialists who are trying to figure out what is wrong with my left arm. I am in a lot of pain and have no strength in it.

On October 3<sup>rd</sup> I will have the joy of doing the wedding ceremony of James and Deborah at the Crossroads Chapel. This is a first for the Crossroads Chapel.

Pray for **Chaplain Gerrit** as he will be leaving for Africa on October 13<sup>th</sup> for a missions trip to work in a children's home and to teach a group of pastors about the importance of marriage.
