For Personal Reflection and Discussion with Friends and Family:

If you could go for a walk with Jesus and He brought up the subject of your witness for Him, what do you think He would say? Would He affirm you for your strong witness or would He urge you to be more vocal for Him? What might He tell you about how you could be a more faithful witness? Even though you and I don't have Jesus here in the flesh to walk and talk with, since He has given us His Spirit to indwell us, we can still ask Him to answer these questions. Take some time this week to do just that!
