#### MISSIONARY OF THE WEEK

#### Cynthia Friesen – in Thailand with MB Mission

Praise God, two weeks in the Juvenile Detention Centre and three girls prayed to receive Christ. We have divided the girls into three groups on Fridays. First group is those who are not yet believers, second group are those who are believers (kind of like a baptism class) and the third group, which I usually lead, is for those who have been baptized. The largest group right now on Friday's is the not yet believers. Many of the girls that have been baptized have moved to the coffee shop outside the prison (they have earned good behaviour points) where they get work experience or they have been released from Juvy to go home.

These last few months have been so full of change in the JDC. We used to meet in a small little 'sala' and those who wanted to join on Fridays would join us. In the last few months, we have moved to the larger main covered area of the Juvy where the girls who didn't attend our bible study would hang out. I'm not sure how this move really happened but now all the girls are attending the group. Of course some only come because there is milk and cookies offered at the end but if that's how they start their journey towards Jesus, we are okay with that:). The challenge is that there is a very obvious spiritual battle going on every Friday, now more than ever. So to see three new believers was just another reminder of God's sovereignty, power, and authority over the darkness. Some of the girls definitely have a few demons so there are even more challenges communicating the gospel every Friday. There is no fear but we realize that this is the reality we are in right now. Please pray for spiritual victory and deliverance for those who need it. Continue to pray for our team of 5 that constantly feel humbled and awed by what the Lord allows us to do in His name for his glory.
