Love's Journey to the Cross - Lent Reflections 2016 February 21 - Our mouths (James 3:9-10, 17-18)

We continue our countdown of the 40 days of Lent leading up to Easter. Let us focus on dving to ourselves and living free in Christ: on love's journey to the cross, and on how God loves us and calls us to love others.

Today we reflect on James 3. Our words show others who we really are. Think about all you've said or written this week... in a letter, an email, a text, on social media... is it good, loving and true?





Greetings from the Crossroads Chapel!

Thank you to all who helped us with the Christmas gift bags for the truckers. We gave out 130 gift bags which included New Testaments, "Way of Salvation" tracts, personal items, goodies and a sandwich at five different Truck Stops. We also gave out 50 meals of hot soup and sandwiches. Seven drivers including a Muslim driver came to the Christmas Day service. The Word was given out. It was an extraordinarily good Christmas. PTL!!

I spent three days at Mission's Fest in Vancouver. The traffic and interest in our ministry was very encouraging. I came home with a bad chest cold which is still lingering. Please pray for a full recovery. I am so thankful for the dedicated chaplains who keep the chapel open even when I cannot be there.

I performed the wedding ceremony for Wayne and Donna last May. In the fall, Donna was diagnosed with cancer. They did surgery a month ago. They opened and closed her back up and gave her a year to live. We went to visit her in hospital and were astounded by her openness to share her faith with everyone. During this journey, we had the joy of seeing Wayne and Donna come to the Lord. They are praising Him and asking Him for a complete healing. Please pray together with us for healing as they face each day with renewed faith and that they will be encouraged again and again. Also, please pray for Chaplain Mel who is having open heart surgery on March 8.

My laptop is 9 years old and is now giving me a lot of problems. The sound card is gone and it is slowly shutting down on me. The new computer I need to do all my office work will cost \$1094.00. Pray that God will supply me with the computer I need.

On a personal note our family is doing well. We are anticipating having them all here for Christmas this year.
