Love's Journey to the Cross - Lent Reflections 2016 March 6 - *Adopted (Luke 15)*



Baptism in water, after deciding to follow Jesus, is the one thing that Jesus asked us to do to declare that we are His followers (Matthew 28:19-20). Ideally, baptism follows faith as soon as possible.

Our baptism as believers also gives us a visible connection with our local church. When we trust Jesus as Saviour and surrender to Him as Lord, He baptizes us in the Holy Spirit, who breathes spiritual life into us making us members of Jesus' spiritual body (1 Corinthians 12:13), His church. Similarly, when we are visibly baptized in water, we become members of our local church, His visible body.

To prepare for baptism and membership, we regularly offer a class, followed by an opportunity to be affirmed by church leaders. Those who have previously been baptized as believers elsewhere, do not need to be baptized at RRCC in order to be received as members but are still asked to attend our membership class and meet with our elders and pastors.

Romans 8:13-17

The indwelling Holy Spirit makes possible every aspect of our life in God's family.

If you are led by the Spirit, you are God's child. (If you aren't, you're not!)

14 For those who are led by the Spirit of God are the children of God.

The Spirit empowers you to relate to God as your own dear Father. (No need for fear!)

15 The Spirit you received does not make you slaves, so that you live in fear again; rather, the Spirit you received brought about your adoption to sonship. And by him we cry, "Abba, Father."

The Spirit assures you that you belong in God's family. (No Spirit; no assurance!)

16 The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are God's children.
As a sibling of the Son, you share with Him both sufferings and glory. (No suffering; no glory!)
For Personal Reflection and Discussion with Friends and Family: How does it feel to know that only those led by the Spirit are God's children? Discouraging (what if I'm not God's child)? Encouraging (As God's child, the Spirit is leading me, even when it doesn't feel like it!)? In what ways does God want to dispel fear from your life, replacing it with the sure sense that Father is your own dear Father? Have you experienced—are you experiencing—the reassuring perspective of counting it all joy when suffering comes your way (Matthew 5:10-12; 1 Peter 4:12-19; James 1:2-4)?

Dear Friends at Ross Road

It has been a trying time these last few months! We have been very busy with a number of projects, the fellowship here, and a group of interns from Canada and Germany. We also heard that 2 families (not from our team) but who have been with us for the last 2 1/2 years are leaving. One of the biggest reasons is the spiritual oppression they have been under. As you might also know - one family from our team is on a sabbatical continuing to process if they are coming back. So we need your prayers! The spiritual pressure is heavy and real. We want to thank you for interceding for us so faithfully. We know we couldn't do it without your help.

A big praise this last 2 weeks is that one of the women that we as a team have been connecting with, a coworker of Mel at our children's school, accepted Jesus into her heart! It was literally the product of prayer as we were targeting her in prayer a few different times and it seemed like she began to ask more and more questions. And then after coming to our fellowship one day, she stayed behind to talk and then prayed (what one of our teammates described as the most sincere prayers he has heard here) and cried out afterwards, "I am clean, I am clean!"

So seeing the power of prayer in her life, can we ask you as a congregation this Sunday to pray for Francis (not her real name). Francis has had a couple of different dreams that have pointed her to Jesus and has been seeking answers to her questions. She has met with B. a few different times and is coming to the fellowship this weekend. Would you lift her up and pray that the Father might draw her to himself! May the Spirit bring conviction and guidance into truth and comfort!
