Frustration

20 For the creation was subjected to frustration, not by its own choice, but by the will of the one who subjected it
22 We know that the whole creation has been groaning as in the pains of childbirth right up to the present time.
23 Not only so, but we ourselves, who have the firstfruits of the Spirit, groan inwardly as we wait eagerly
Anticipation 18 Our present sufferings are not worth comparing with the glory that will be revealed in us. 19 For the creation waits in eager expectation for the children of God to be revealed.
20 in hope 21 that the creation itself will be liberated from its bondage to decay and brought into the freedom and glory of the children of God.

23as we wait eagerly for our adoption to sonship, the redemption of our bodies.
24 For in this hope we were saved. But hope that is seen is no hope at all. Who hopes for what they already have? 25 But if we hope for what we do not yet have, we wait for
it patiently.
Provision
26 In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us through wordless groans. 27 And he who searches our hearts knows the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for God's people in accordance with the will of God.
For Personal Reflection and Discussion with Friends and Family:

Why do we get bogged down in our "present sufferings," forgetting that they "are not worth comparing to the glory that will be revealed in us?" For what have you waited in eager expectation lately? (A vacation? A visit from family? A new home? A shopping trip?) How can you cooperate with the Spirit's work in you to wait more eagerly the forever-results of your adoption into God's family? How does the Spirit's presence in you encourage you about eternity? How does or might a strong, eternal hope help you to deal with current difficulties more patiently? How can you cooperate with the Spirit in prayer, as he intercedes for you through wordless groans?

In Preparation for Next Sunday, March 20, 2016:

Romans 8:28 is one of the most often quoted verses in the Bible, right up there with John 3:16. Next Sunday we'll study the verse in the context of Romans 8:28-30, as Pastor Art shares the message, "Conformed to the Son." Take some time to study the paragraph prayerfully, asking God to show you His heart in the "all things" circumstances of your life.
