Love's Journey to the Cross - Lent Reflection 2016 March 27 - God's Victorious Love (1 Corinthians 5; Ephesians 3; Romans 10)

Today is the day we celebrate God's victorious love! Today, we reflect and celebrate. Jesus is no longer in the grave! He lives! Hallelujah! Because of Jesus' resurrection, we can say "Oh death, where is your victory? ...Oh death, where is your sting?" Our Good Father gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. Because of Jesus, we live not for victory, we live from victory. If we confess with our mouths that Jesus is Lord of every area of our lives, we are saved. May we choose this day to love and live in Christ's victory!

How can I be right with God?

Romans 10:9 9 If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

What does it mean to be saved?

What does it mean to declare with your mouth?

How do you know that Jesus is Lord?

What does it mean to believe in your heart?

How do you know that God raised Jesus from the dead?

How does declaring that Jesus is Lord and believing that God raised Jesus from the dead save?

Romans 10:10 10 For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved.

Genuine trust in Jesus as risen Lord and Saviour is the only way be right with God.

For Personal Reflection and Discussion with Friends and Family:

How do you know that Jesus is LORD, that is, that He is none other than the infinite, eternal YAHWEH? What difference does it make? Why wouldn't it have been enough for Him to be a great person or an angel come to our rescue? AND what reasons do we have to believe that Jesus came back to life? What difference does the resurrection make? That is, wouldn't it have been enough for Him simply to die for us? Are you confident that you are right with God? What gives you this confidence?

In Preparation for Next Sunday, April 3, 2016:

Next Sunday morning we move on in Romans 10 to verses 14-17, which challenge us to "Bring Good News." Prayerfully read Romans 10, asking God to give you opportunities and courage to bring the Good News.
