The Difference

"Honour your father and your mother, so that you may live long in the land the LORD your God is giving you." Exodus 20:12

Our Massamá Church is still going through some very tough times, with their recent change in location. Another place has been found, but this is very hard, and it's testing the resilience of the believers. Our Amadora (African) Church meets in the same location as the Massamá Church, so they have also had to readjust to a new space. Please pray for these two churches, that they are resilient and remain steadfast in their faith. We have developed a basic discipleship program that includes ministry time, study time, and work (in the real world). Currently two interns from Germany are participating, and some of our own University students and grads are getting involved and participating in various aspects of this program. We are looking for 4 to 6 young people that are willing to commit to one year and join this program. Please pray for our interns and that this initiative take hold!

For some years we have tried to help people find jobs and make a living with dignity. An area we feel God pushing us into is focused on job development for the many unemployed, young and old. A project we have begun this past year is called "A Ponte" (The Bridge), it is an Entrepreneurial Incubator and Co Work Space for business and social projects. One of our greatest needs is finding a full-time business person that would be willing to answer God's call to come and work with us in this project. The challenge is big, the opportunities greater yet!
