And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love.

¹⁸ may have power, together with all the saints, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, ¹⁹ and to know this love that surpasses knowledge— that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God.

²⁰ Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us, ²¹ to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! Amen.

On My Heart:

"Jesus, the Lamb Worthy of All Praise"

Revelation 1:5-6; 4:1-11; 5:5-14

Key Truth: The Lord Jesus Christ is worthy of our ceaseless, unlimited love, worship, and praise.

1. John praises Jesus. Rev. 1:4-8

Rev. 1: 5b - 6 " To Him who loves us and has freed us from our sins by His blood, and has made us to be a kingdom and priests to serve His God and Father - to Him be glory and power for ever and ever! Amen.

Truth: Jesus Christ is worthy of our ceaseless, unlimited love, worship and praise because He loves us and has freed us from our sins.

Challenge: How does my response to my Lord Jesus measure up to what it should be, given His sacrificial love and grace shown to me? What will I change today in the way I worship Him?

2. John sees the perpetual worship of God on His throne. Rev. 4:1-11

Rev. 4:2 "At once I was in the Spirit, and there before me was a throne in heaven with someone sitting on it."

Truth: Because God made this world and all that is in it, including us, He is worthy of our humble praise, every day, all day!

Challenge: How often, in twenty-four hours of each day do I give God the praise He deserves? How much MORE will I worship Him?
3. John sees the glorified Lamb that was slain on the throne receiving worship. Rev. 5:5-14
Rev. 5:6 "Then I saw a Lamb, looking as if it had been slain, standing in the centre of the throne"
Truth: Because Jesus Christ gave His life and died to fee me from my sins, He is WORTHY to receive ALL I have and am.
Challenge: What will you and I offer back to our Lord Jesus today that we may have been holding back from Him?
For Personal Reflection

Prayerfully examine your present personal response to the Lord. Ask Him to show you how you can enjoy an even more vibrant, wholehearted worship of Him in ALL you do ALL day, than maybe you do now. And then ask Him to help you PRAISE Him with a NEW JOY in your worship that you may not have experienced before.
