



October Prayer Encounter—"Together:" City Church Worship and Prayer—

At Seven Oaks Alliance Church on October 23rd at 6:30pm. Because Thanksgiving Sunday is the second Sunday, normally the day of our monthly Prayer Encounter, and because the Abbotsford Christian Leaders' Network is inviting all Abbotsford Christians to a "Together" event on Sunday evening, October 23, the elders urge as many of us as possible to participate in that event as though it were our own Prayer Encounter.

Drop-in Centre at the Centre of Hope in Funding Crunch



We have been informed that, effective October 3, the Drop-In Centre run by the Centre of Hope will need to curtail its operations due to lack of funds. Effectively that means, among other things, that 18,000 nutritious breakfasts (which would have been served between now and March 31) will not be served. Other services will also need to be curtailed (including the provision of toiletries, laundry, showers, socks, undergarments). And all of this is to be lost as we head into the cold weather months of Fall and Winter, when the demand for these services increases. The cost to keep the Drop-In is \$65,000. Salvation Army would welcome financial help to avert this limitation of services.

Why reject the Church?

1. Jesus envisions His disciples in community, not as loners.

"....my church...."

2. The church is so important to Jesus that He Himself is building it.

"I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not overcome it."

3. Jesus has a role for every disciple in His church.

"And I tell you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church...."

4. Jesus designed the church to open the doors of His kingdom to outsiders.

"I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven; whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven."

5. Jesus designed the church as a community in which members take responsibility for one another.

"...tell it to the church...."

Jesus is building His church because He wants His followers in a community that disciples.

For Personal Reflection and Discussion with Friends and Family: The Spirit informs us in Ephesians 5:25 that "...Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her...." How does knowledge of Jesus' commitment to build and love His church impact how you feel about it? What drains your love for His church? What grows your love for it?

In Preparation for Next Sunday, October 9, 2016:
