

What Jesus Is Saying to Us

Having loved his own who were in the world, he loved them to the end. "A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another." 13:1, 34

Jesus: "Unless I wash you, you have no part with me."

Peter: "Then, Lord, not just my feet but my hands and my head as well!" **Jesus:** "Those who have had a bath need only to wash their feet; their whole body is clean. And you are clean, though not every one of you." 13:8-10

I have set you an example that you should do as I have done for you. Very truly I tell you, no servant is greater than his master, nor is a messenger greater than the one who sent him. 13:15-16
