

FAQ's and Safety Measures

- 1. Is the Day Camp open to all ages? The camp is open for children going into Grade 1 through Grade 6.
- 2. What activities will my child be participating in? We are going to spend lots of time outdoors on our field playing games, making crafts, and having story time. For the story portion we may go inside to the gym, however the gym is large enough to allow everyone to maintain adequate physical distancing.
- 3. When does registration open? Registration will go live on Friday, July 31, at 4 p.m.
- **4. Will I need to sign a waiver?** Yes! You will receive a separate email after you've registered with a waiver form that you'll need to complete and bring the first day of camp.
- **5. Will my child need to wear a mask and gloves to camp?** No, participants are not required to wear a mask and gloves. That said, if your child has health issues that put them at higher risk, we do recommend that they come with a mask and gloves.
- 6. What safety measures are in place due to Covid-19?

We are following the recommendations from the Provincial Health Officer, WorkSafeBC and BCRPA, and will be:

- Reviewing a safety checklist each morning prior to the start of camp.
- Conducting a daily health screening of each participant and volunteer leader. Anyone who shows any kind of symptoms will not be allowed to participate. (see page 2 for health screening questionnaire)
- Increasing the frequency of daily cleaning and sanitizing of high traffic touch-points.
- Providing extra hand sanitizer and hand-washing stations both outdoors and indoors.
- Increasing the frequency of hand-washing for all participants and volunteer leaders.
- Limiting the number of participants in each camp.
- Spending time outdoors as much as possible.

7. What happens if my child or someone else at camp becomes ill or starts showing symptoms of Covid-19?

- If a child becomes ill, we will contact their parent or legal guardian to come pick them up right away. The child will be removed from the other campers, provided with a mask and kept in a supervised area separate from the other campers, until they are picked up. When the child has left, a deep clean of the space they were occupying will be conducted.
- If a volunteer leader becomes ill, we will notify their emergency contact to advise them that the volunteer is ill and is coming home. If the volunteer is not well enough to drive home unaccompanied, we will ask their emergency contact to come pick the volunteer up right away. The volunteer will be provided with a mask and kept in a supervised area separate from the campers and other volunteers, until they are picked up. When the volunteer has left, a deep clean of the space they were occupying will be conducted.
- We will contact Fraser Health for instructions, including the necessary steps for notifying anyone that may have come into contact with the participant or volunteer.
